Disability service providers, advocates and community stakeholders are invited to explore the latest NDIS reforms and the impact for people with disability, carers, service providers and the broader community.

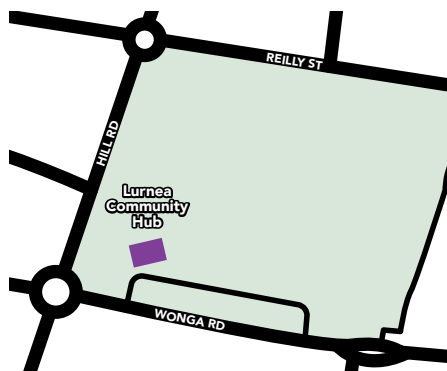
- Hear from guest speakers on recent changes to the NDIS and what they mean for the sector.
